

The new Squier Stratocaster faithfully captures the sound and spirit of the world's most popular electric guitar — an instrument that has reigned unchallenged since its introduction almost three decades ago. The three single-coil pickups, the fast action, the sensuous body shape, and the ringing, knife-edged sound —all are inspired by the immortal Stratocaster Modern touches include the larger head-stock, three-bolt neck attachment,



and an updated 5-position switch that allows selecting the middle pickup in combination with either the bridge or neck pickup.

With a body shaped of solid, select hardwoods finished in gleaming black or white, and your choice of classic Maple or Rosewood fretboard, a Squier Stratocaster is an instrument that anybody from student to professional can play with pride.

Squier Telecaster®

All Bullet guitars feature Stratocaster-style body shapes (in Black or Sunburst finish) combined with one-piece rock maple necks patterned after the Telecaster. Precision tuning machines assure smooth, slip-free tuning, while the adjustable bridge and neck truss rod make it easy to set your Bullet up for any string gauge and playing style.

Model S-3 offers three singlecoil pickups in the traditional Stratocaster arrangement, with or without tremolo. The Bullet H-2 offers the unique versatility of two humbucking pickups, each switchable to single-coil operation. Both are finely constructed, easy-playing winners!





Squier makes the sound and feel of Fender's most successful bass guitars available for remarkably little money. You get a choice of two finely-crafted instruments, incorporating many of the features that have made Fender basses the standard since the very beginning.
